Location/ Dates: The meeting was held in the town of Mikulov within the Eurotrialog project from 26/08/2016 to 28/08/2016.

Short description:

The day of **26/08/2016** was dedicated to welcome of partners and to EU topics starting with their foundations. The first day was adapted to ceremonial welcome of the partners and all participants. This day was held in the spirit of partnership. The prepared activities encouraged the participants to get to know each other more closely. At the joint sitting of representatives cooperation so far and current information about happenings in the EU and individual member states were discussed. Through insights into the lives of people in less developed countries, through debates with volunteers who work with them, we learned what they really need.

Through history and diversity of the EU we moved to learning about priorities, visions and goals of the EU and to discussions with representatives of NGOs about current events in the EU. It is very important to understand the EU as a whole. The evening was marked by lovely musical performances during which space was created for open discussions on European themes among the participants of the partner municipalities.

The day of **27/08/2016** was dedicated to diverse activities starting from EU themes through musical performances to the presentations of non-profit organizations and not least highlighting young talents.

The morning of the second day was full of colorful activities in the form of discussions focusing on current events in the EU, through a musical component which relieved tension from the EU topics and provided more space for storing ideas. For children a playful activity was prepared in the form of familiarization with the countries of the EU. We do not forget the importance of spreading and focusing on volunteerism.

The evening program was focused not only on the topic of Euro-skepticism, but on musical performances as well. The partner municipalities are joined by an immense love for music, through which a huge amount of emotions can be expressed in a nonverbal way.

We paid our attention to young talents to be developed, who deserve more attention. A friendly atmosphere was created among all the participants of the event, regardless of age or nationality.

The day of **28/08/2016** day was devoted to the reinforcement of partnerships, not only because of the love for music but also the knowledge of EU issues.

The morning of the third day was devoted to children in the form of a language window and also through folk customs, crafts and traditions. Immense love for traditions is a strong bond among the partner municipalities. The whole experience of traditions was reinforced by singing folk songs. It is very important to pass on traditions from generation to generation.

The afternoon was devoted not only to visions for the future within the EU but also to the joint sitting of all participants thanks to which the great experience of the three-day event was reinforced in the form of narrating experiences. The event was closed by a beautiful singing performances.
