Head to Mikulov Castle and discover its rich exhibitions. You can look forward to fascinating stories about the Dietrichstein family, a wine exhibition with a giant barrel, and an archaeological exhibition dedicated to the Romans and Germanic tribes.



Sights

Discover the unique sights of Mikulov, a town with a rich history, unmistakable genius loci, and the taste of Moravian wine. The Baroque castle, Svatý kopeček (Holy Hill), Jewish quarter, and historic square will draw you into the authentic atmosphere of South Moravia.

Wine

The Mikulov region is famous for its wines – Welschriesling, Grüner Veltliner, Chardonnay and Pálava – with their typical freshness and aroma. Taste wines at local wineries, stroll through the vineyards, and let the tranquility and stories of this landscape work their magic on you. Enjoy the atmosphere of wine festivals and tastings, where wine is combined with music, gastronomy, and a friendly atmosphere.



Cultural events

Mikulov is alive with culture all year round – from music festivals, live concerts, and open-air theaters to exhibitions, author readings, and traditional celebrations. The highlight of the season is the Pálava Wine Harvest in September, which attracts tens of thousands of visitors every year. The summer studios of the Mikulov art symposium "dílňa" are also worth a visit.

Laa an der Thaya

Castle

A dominant feature of the town and part of its coat of arms. This 13th-century castle with its characteristic Butterfassturm tower offers a magnificent view of Laa an der Thaya, the surrounding countryside, and as far as the Czech Republic from its viewing platform. Open daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., admission €2.



Sights

Historic town square with a magnificent town hall, impressive 13th-century town walls, and Laa Castle. Experience fascinating city tours and night watches and immerse yourself in the rich history with many interesting places in Laa an der Thaya.

Thermal Spa

Treat yourself to perfect relaxation at Therme Laa – with its extensive water world, elegant saunas, and exclusive Silent Spa. New additions include Silent Villas – a luxurious retreat for adults only. Relax amid the picturesque landscape of the Weinviertel region.



Cultural events

Throughout the year, Laa hosts a variety of colorful events, ranging from art to cabaret. One of the highlights is the Onion Festival in August! Three days of music, good cheer, and culinary specialties made from onions on the historic town square.
